- Further develop staff capacity to deliver the digital classroom and health and wellbeing improvement priorities.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Develop individualised support plans for every student using a case management approach.

Our initiatives include

- Increasing hours for skilled teacher aides working with teachers to deliver specific intervention programs
- Providing release time for teachers to establish individual support plans.
- Ongoing professional learning for all staff.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Professional learning for staff to develop capability to teach digital technology, and embed the use of ICPs across learning areas to differentiate or all students. (\$1000)
- Employing additional staff to support the initiatives of: intensive learning for small groups in reading and writing for students who are working below, or at risk of being below, the National Minimum Standards in NAPLAN (\$2935)
- Purchasing teacher release time for establishing individual support plans, data analysis and moderation of student work (\$1600)
